

## Kindergarten Discipline Plan

The kindergartners will soon be introduced to all of the school rules (playground, classroom, and the school wide 49 essential rules).

The students understand that they have choices to make when it comes to the rules. There are rewards for following the rules and there are consequences for not following the rules. In addition to the 49 essential rules the students have agreed to emphasize the following classroom rules.

1. Sit in your chair appropriately.
2. Raise your hand to answer questions.
3. Listen carefully. One person talks at a time.
4. Take care of your materials and supplies.
5. Treat others kindly (no teasing, hitting, etc.).
6. Wait your turn.
7. Try your best to do quality work.
8. No throwing anything (except balls at recess).
9. Play safely (follow the playground rules).
10. No talking or playing during quiet time.
11. No playing in the bathroom.

### Rewards/Consequences

The classroom code of conduct (found in student handbook) will be enforced.

### Student of the Month

Students who consistently follow the school rules, display good manners, have a positive attitude, complete their work in a timely manner or improvement is shown in these area may be nominated for student of the month. One student from each class is nominated and then voted on by the staff. Every effort is made to honor different students each month however, a student can be student of the month for more than one month.

### Kindergarten Dollars

Students who are following the rules will receive a “Kindergarten Dollar” when they are “caught” following the rules. Students will have the opportunity to shop with their dollars at the end of each trimester.

### BYB (Bee Your Best)

Students are given a card each month with the “character trait” for the month printed on it. Every time the student is caught using the “character trait” of the month they will get one of the letters punched out. If they get all of their letters punched, they will be allowed to attend the event. Each month a different “character trait” will be emphasized.

September - Respect

December - Kindness

March - Self-Control

October - Responsibility

January - Friendliness

April - Quality

November - Citizenship

February - Honesty
