

Back to School Information “Go Thunder”

Welcome to the 2020-2021 school year! I hope everyone is excited and ready for the year ahead. The first day of school for Kindergarten through 8th grade is Tuesday, September 1. The first day for 4K is Wednesday, September 9. Our school day hours are 8:15-3:25.

Thanks for all your support at the end of last year, over the summer, and at our recent parent meetings. Everyone at Kansasville School is committed to the health and safety of our students and families. Please help us keep the kids healthy and in school.

Due to Covid-19, we have had to make many changes to the school building, room layouts, and classroom routines this year. Below are some of the main details:

- Much of the shelving, reading rugs, tables, and extras have been moved or removed to make ample room for social distancing.
- Face coverings are required this year in order for us to be open for in-person learning. If your child has not had to wear a face covering much this summer, please have them get used to wearing one to make the transition easier.
- Face coverings are also required on the school bus.
- The students will be given outside class time, recess, and physical education class as much as possible to give them mask-free breaks.
- Please check daily and keep your child home if they are experiencing any Covid-19 symptoms. These may include: Any unexplained cough, fever, shortness of breath, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell, chills, runny nose, nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea.
- If someone becomes ill, the Central Racine County Health Department will help us to follow the most recent protocols.
- Student desks and chairs will be cleaned and sanitized several times each day. The entire school will be sanitized nightly.
- Hand washing/Sanitizer will be used by everyone entering the building and before/after recess.
- Staff will be teaching students good handwashing, sanitizing, and social distancing practices.
- Guests and field trips will not be allowed at this time.
- Student sign in/out will be done in the main entrance lobby.
- Water bottle fill stations are open but bubblers are closed.
- Hot lunch this year will start out with only one choice.
- Only three students will be eating at a lunch table in order to maintain six feet social distancing.
