Welcome! There are 21 (14 boys and 7 girls) wonderful children enrolled in our 4K and Kindergarten this year. We are very excited to be working with your child and so are the "special" teachers your child will be working with. Our special classes are as follows:

Monday

Art: Mrs. Myers (Please make sure your child has an old shirt or smock at school for painting and messy projects.)

Tuesday

Gym: Mr. Christensen

Wednesday

Guidance: Mrs. Thomas

Music: Mrs. Myers

Mrs. Paegelow (5K Only - Please make sure your child returns their library books by Wednesday.) Your child will be able to check out one book a week.

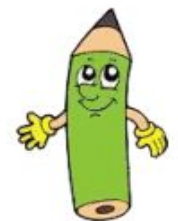
Thursday

Friday:

Gym: Mr. Stratton (Please make sure your child has gym shoes for class. **MUST HAVE RUBBER SOLES – Foam or Felt soles are too dangerous to have on the gym floor.**

They need to be kept here at school. The shoes cannot be worn outdoors during recess. They will get the gym floor dirty. You might want to keep an extra pair of socks here at school for those days your child wears sandals to school.)



Everyday:

Snack time: 9:30 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. (See snack letter for details.)

Lunch time: 12:00 a.m. - 12:30 p.m. Students who have not purchased hot lunch can order either white or chocolate milk to drink with their lunch for \$.10. Lunch is \$3.35 which includes milk. Most Fridays the students will have an opportunity to purchase a dessert for \$1.00. Students eat both snack and lunch in the classroom. Students are given 30 minutes to eat lunch. I will encourage your child to eat everything in their lunch but they may not finish everything. Cold lunch students are asked to bring any left over items home so you can gauge what to pack.

Show & Tell: Show & tell items can be brought in on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays. We will start on Monday, October 5, 2020. We will send a schedule home to let you know which days your child will be able to bring in show & tell. Sometimes students want to bring their toys in to play with at recess. We discourage children from bringing in toys to play with at recess. If they choose to bring in toys to play with at recess, they are responsible for their care and for bringing them back in. The staff always feels badly when the toys become broken or lost. Thanks for all of your help and cooperation regarding toys brought from home.

We will be using Class Dojo this year for most of our communication. Please find the note in this folder and sign-up using the class code. Notes will occasionally be sent home in their take home folders to keep you informed of the activities your child will be participating in as well. (Please check the website, school calendar, and your email for updates as well.) We may also send work home with your child. We will stamp homework on the papers that need to be returned to school. Generally, if the paper has not been completed in school it is homework. If your child is absent all paperwork missed will be sent home with another family member or on the day they return to school. Homework is never given on Friday.

Students will also have the chance to purchase books once a month from different educational book clubs. These materials are generally of a high quality and are of a high interest to children. Please send the order back to school in an envelope with the slip (don't forget your name) and money enclosed. You may put all orders in one envelope and make the check payable to Scholastic Books. You may also choose to order online. The instructions and code are on the note attached to the book orders every month.

We will be working with your child's handwriting all year and do not expect your child to know how to write all of the letters and numbers at this time. However, your child will be expected to print his/her first name. It will be necessary for identification of personal belongings and papers. Please practice this skill with your child. Your child will also need to practice reciting their full name, address, phone number and birth date.

It is important to have a good parent-teacher-child relationship. We want your child to experience educational success and happiness during the school year.
