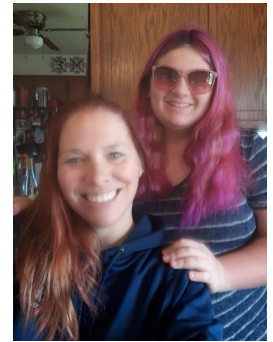

I have been teaching at Kansasville since 2014. I graduated with my teaching degree from UW LaCrosse in 2012 and I received my Reading Specialist certification from UW Stout in 2019. How the classroom works

Reading: Your child will have reading, spelling, language arts, and writing with me. We do novel studies in class and your child will have reading homework at night. I strongly encourage you to read with your child.

Math: Mr. Christensen will be teaching math this year. We use Go Math as our math curriculum. It does follow the common core and can often be confusing. If you ever need help with Math, your child can log into their Go Math online and show you the lesson.

Homework: Yes, there may be work to take home that wasn't finished in class. Homework is always due the next day. Homework should take no more than 30-40 minutes a night, if it does, please let me know.



Class Dojo: A sign up sheet will be sent to you. Please sign up using the directions on the sheet. Mr. Christensen and I use Class Dojo for all of our communication! We also share pictures and achievements. You can also message us through Dojo with any questions.

Snack: We have snack everyday. Each child is responsible for bringing in their own snack. Candy, suckers, and gum are not snacks. Please make sure your child is bringing a nutritious snack to fuel their brain.

Birthday treats: Birthday treats are always welcome. This year we are asking that they are individually wrapped and store bought. Thanks for understanding.

Birthday Invitations: If you would like me to hand out birthday invites, you need to either invite all of one gender or all of one grade as to not leave anyone out. For example you can invite all the girls in the class or all of the 3rd grade class.

Parties: We have classroom parties for Christmas, Valentine's Day, Halloween and Spring. There is always a signup on SignUp Genius. The link will be sent to you in your email.

Computers: It is your child's responsibility to bring their computer to school each day, charged and ready to go.

Assignment notebooks: Assignment notebooks are to be checked over and signed each day by a parent or guardian. I will ensure that they are coming home filled out, so you know what work your child has to complete.
